



What Are Cookies?

Cookies are the information a computer receives and sends back to your device without changing or altering it. These are text files, such as usernames and passwords, that help the website to recognize your network. Websites often use cookies to help keep track of your visits and activity. This allows websites to more effectively cater to you and remember things such as items you added to your cart or previous searches.

Types of Cookies We Use

Source Receivables Management uses “Session Cookies.” Session cookies are only used while navigating our website. When you leave our website, these cookies are automatically deleted. Session cookies help functionalities such as the “back button” recognize the page you are trying to reach.

Source Receivables Management uses “Security Cookies.” Security cookies help identify and prevent security risks. We use these cookies to authenticate users and protect user data from unauthorized parties.

Source Receivables Management uses Google Analytics to store information on how visitors use our site. This helps tell us where the visitor came from, number of pages displayed, and number of visits. This allows us to make improvements to our website.
